1. The Plainfield Park District requires proof of residency when purchasing a season pass: a current driver's license, voter's registration card or tax bill.
2. When registering, please include all names and birthdates of family members you are purchasing a family pass for on your registration form.
3. Family Pass: includes Father and/or Mother and all children who are under 18 years of age who have permanent residency at the family address.
4. Senior Pass: Senior Citizen is anyone 55 and older.
5. Individuals 16 and older are required to show a Drivers License/State I.D. before they may pick up his/her pass.
6. Each family member will be issued a pass bearing their name.

LEARN-TO-SWIM REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Policies

During your first lesson, each child is evaluated and adjustments will be made according to your child's skill level. When registering for more than one session, be sure to enroll them into the same level for each session. At the end of the session, your child may be moved to a higher level upon successful completion of their current level program content.

Cancellations

Swim lessons will not be canceled due to low temperatures. In the event your lesson is cancelled, the second Friday of the session will be used as a make-up date. Only one make-up per session can be made-up. The Plainfield Park District reserves the right to cancel or change Ottawa Street Pool swim lessons or programs due to insufficient registration or as conditions warrant.

It is designed to give students a positive learning experience while teaching aquatic and safety skills in a logical progression. The objective is to teach people to swim and to be safe in, on and around the water.

Group Lessons
